

# **Spring 2017 Updates and Announcements**

The Oregon Water Coalition has recently undergone a series of exciting changes. This newsletter will provide updates on these changes, as well as a look ahead to upcoming events. In January, the Coalition hired Marika Sitz as coordinator to handle day to day operations. Marika was born and raised in Pendleton. She graduated from Pendleton High School in 2011 and from Stanford University in June 2015 with a degree in Human Biology, concentrating on Food and Agriculture Systems. After graduating from college, she spent a year working at Stanford's Bill Lane Center for the American West as a program associate. In this role, she ran the internship program and coordinated events and general outreach. Additionally, her time at the Center allowed her to interact with researchers working on issues related to groundwater, energy development, and the rural-urban divide. In her new position as coordinator, Marika will strive to make the Oregon Water Coalition relevant for members.

In February, the Board of Directors voted to begin the transition of the OWC from a 501(c)(6) to a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. This status change will increase the Coalition's eligibility for grant funding while allowing it to continue its mission of promoting education about water and agriculture issues and ensuring that northeast Oregon isn't a forgotten voice in state legislation and issues.

# **New Projects and Initiatives**

Since January, the Oregon Water Coalition has been working to lay the groundwork for its new endeavors. The newly launched website features a selection of irrigation and agriculture fact sheets created through a collaboration with the SAGE Center. We hope to continue working with the SAGE Center in the coming months.

In April, the OWC applied for a grant from the Wildhorse Foundation to support the 'Sustainable Ag Blast' conference. The goal of this conference is to bring representatives of media sources and environmental groups from the western side of the state to Eastern Oregon for an immersive three-day conference focusing on the economic value of agriculture to the region, and the developments in water use efficiency in the Basin. More details on this event will be forthcoming.

In late 2017 or early 2018, the Oregon Water Coalition will host a Water Summit geared towards Coalition members and citizens of northeastern Oregon. The aim of this conference will be to bring together farmers and business from beyond the Umatilla Basin to discuss regional water challenges and potential solutions.
